- Call Back Auditions: December 20, 21, 8:00am in the Music Room
- Rehearsals begin after Winter Break. (week of January 8 12) Rehearsals are, Tuesdays and Wednesdays before school (8:00). Rehearsal schedule will be posted weekly at: Kcosman.weebly.com/chorus

As you well know, rehearsals are extremely important to the success of any show. Here are some commonsense rules, which will help make rehearsals efficient, productive, and fun for everyone:

- 1. Be on time for every rehearsal. The show waits for no one.
- 2. Always bring a pencil (not a pen) to rehearsals to take notes in your script.
- 3. Bring your script to every rehearsal.
- Cast members are required to be at ALL rehearsals for which they are scheduled and ALL shows. Only those cast members who are needed are called to rehearsals. If you miss rehearsal, you have missed out on learning your part.
- If an absence is necessary, in case of illness or emergency, three absences are allowed. Those missing more than three rehearsals may not be able to participate.
- The musical will not be an excuse for unfinished homework or not being prepared for any class, just as homework and extracurricular activities are not an excuse for not practicing at home to be prepared for rehearsal.

Behavior Contract Rehearsal and Performance Guidelines

- Respect for Directors, parent helpers, and teachers is expected at all times.
- Avoid unnecessary noise and distractions during rehearsals and performances.
- Stay in designated areas. Students may not leave the rehearsal area at any time during rehearsals or performances.
- Be respectful of all equipment and props. Do not touch a prop unless directed to do so, avoid touching ropes or curtains backstage.
- Make SURE to leave the area as clean as it was when you arrived. Clean up any garbage and properly put costumes and props away at the end of each rehearsal.
- Behave in a professional manner:
 - a. Attend all rehearsals and performances unless you are ill.
 - b. Be on time.
 - c. Be prepared with scripts and a pencil.

2. Director will call the parent and explain the behavior of the student.

3. Principal will talk with student (if warranted), and dismissal from the show may result.

AUDITIONING IS A BREEZE

- 1. Please sign up for an audition outside of the Music Room. Complete the audition form. including student and parent/guardian signatures, and bring it with you to your audition in the music room on December 14th or 15^h.
- 2. Those who are auditioning should prepare the material before coming to the audition if you wish to be seriously considered for a role. Sing Vocal Warm-up (Mah Moh Moo - -), Happy Birthday in the Key of G and Bb, and prepared dialoged to be performed by memory with Mr. Cosman to showcase your range of emotions. Be ready to say your lines excited, sad, angry, and evil.
